## Engagement Plan

This Engagement Plan is to inform any potentially affected parties of the nature and extent of the application for a Land Use Permit with the intention of extracting gravel. Furthermore this plan provides the opportunity to comment on the operation and raise any concerns or questions.

The purpose of this engagement is to address any concerns in regards to the proposed land use.

Affected parties/ communities will be engaged throughout the life of the Land Use Permit, prior to renewing, extending, altering the terms or upon expiry of the agreement.

A list of affected parties was provided by Tyree Mullaney from the Mackenzie Valley Land and Water Board (MVLWB). The list included name, organization and email address and can be seen in Appendix A. In total, 34 potentially affected parties were contacted via email in an initial engagement with the following email:

*I would like to take the opportunity to advise that Rowe's Construction is in the process of applying to:*

- 1) the Government of Northwest Territories, Department of Lands for a Quarry Permit and*
- 2) the Mackenzie Valley Land and Water Board for a Land Use Permit.*

*Both, Quarry and Land Use permits, are to establish a quarry located at Highway 1, kilometre 100 for the purpose of removing gravel. This proposed quarry is located in between our existing quarry at kilometre 99.7 and the GNWT quarry at kilometre 101.1.*

A map, showing the outlines of the proposed quarry, coordinates and adjacent areas, was attached to the email. These initial emails were sent out on January 12th and 15th. A follow up engagement email will be send out on February 19th to complete this stage of engagement. A preliminary Engagement Log is attached to the application and will be submitted in complete form once the first engagement stage is finished.

### Ongoing Engagement

As mentioned above, all affected parties/ communities will be engaged throughout the life of the Land Use Permit and its potential extension. Regular communications with all contacts from the provided list from MVLWB will be carried out before the commencement of site work or any additional stages in clearing and/or exposing granular material within the approved quarry area. As mentioned in the additional information of the Land Use Permit application, we will clear and work the quarry area in stages to only expose material that is needed to remove and leave as much area in natural conditions as possible. We will also provide an annually update for all affected parties on work done in the previous year such as area worked within and material removed.

An ongoing engagement log, separate from the initial engagement log, will be developed and continuously updated as potential concerns or issues arise. With an annually update to all parties and the communication prior to renewing, extending, altering the terms or upon the expiry of the agreement, Rowe's Construction is trying to be proactive in the engagement.

The ongoing engagement log as well as all correspondence with any affected party, will be submitted to MVLWB.
