Issuance of Quarry Permit at Km 100, NWT Highway No. 1

This letter is to inform you that the Government of the Northwest Territories (GNWT) Department of Lands is issuing a quarry permit at Km 100, NWT Highway No. 1.

BACKGROUND

A quarry permit has existed at this site since 2018 and the permit expires on February 4, 2021. Rowe's Construction is requesting 3000 cubic metres of gravel from this existing location. It is important to note that the quarry boundaries identified in this application are the same boundaries previously applied for on February 5, 2018 and are not proposed to change.
