Good afternoon Tyree,

Yes, I just received the email which comes to our surprise. We will have an internal discussion of how to proceed and then get back to you.

Ronald Schaub, our General Manager, has attended the council meeting and has addressed all their concerns. The West Point First Nation appreciated our engagement and it seemed we had addressed and resolved their concerns, which is why I have asked for a follow up with a support letter.

Along with the request for the support letter, I have also provided a map showing our proposed quarry location, the location of their hunting cabin (with the GNWT quarry in between) and have again referred to Norm McCowans (GNWT Lands) letter stating that the proposed quarry location is not on the mentioned region of withdrawn land, which I also illustrated in the map using the MACA ATLAS tool.

We will contact West Point First Nation and resolve the confusion.

Greetings Tyree:

On March 13, 2018 Chief and Council had an opportunity to meet with Ron Schuab, Rowe's Construction. Afterwards, Council discussed their initial comments and affirmed that they do not support the application at this time. In addition to comments made in their previous letter, Council is also concerned that

the quarry activities will impact traditional activities carried out at a hunting cabin at located at km 115.

The following afternoon (March 14, 2018) West Point First Nation received follow up correspondence from Florian Mandsfeld. In addition, feedback from Susan Fleck, Dehcho Land Use Planning Committee, was also received by our office that afternoon. As a result of the incoming correspondence, a second Council Meeting was scheduled to review the feedback with Chief and Council.

Again Council has decided that it does not support the quarry/land use application at this time and they do not want to withdraw their previous letter. WPFN, a member of the Dehcho First Nations, does not consent to the quarry and land use permits at this time. The location at km 100 falls within a region of withdrawn lands and is considered a new quarry that did not exist prior to May 23, 2001, the date the IMA was signed. In addition, the community has stated that quarrying activities in the area will impact traditional activities carried out at a hunting cabin at located at km 115.
