Given that the Project has the potential to adversely impact SLFN, particularly with regard to the caribou we rely on, we would like to invite you to visit our Territory for an in-person meeting to learn more about the Project and develop a clear process for consultation.</p> <p>We would also like to request financial capacity from Dominion Diamond Mines to undertake a comprehensive review of your Project with our experts, which include traditional knowledge holders and western scientists. We require capacity to conduct a First Nation Independent Technical Review (FNITR) of all projects within our Territory and lands that our members use to sustain their way of life to ensure that both the proponent and SLFN fully understand the potential impacts of the proposed Project on our constitutionally protected Aboriginal and Treaty rights. **Re: New Land Use Permit Application for "Harry Winston Property", South of Lac de Gras, NT**

Please be advised that in the coming months Dominion Diamond Mines ULC (Dominion) will be submitting a new Land Use Permit (LUP) application for the "Harry Winston Property", south of Lac de Gras, NT (see the attached figure). This new permit application will replace the current LUP for this area, MV2012C0009, which was issued in 2013 and extended for a two year term until March 6, 2020. Information on the current LUP for this area is available on the Mackenzie Valley Land and Water Board online public registry at <https://mvlwb.com/registry/MV2012C0009>.

The activities being applied for are much the same as those that are currently permitted under MV2012C0009 which are:

- mineral exploration including geochemical and geoscience (geophysical) surveys;
- diamond drilling and reverse-circulation drilling programs;
- fuel storage;
- use of vehicles/equipment;
- operation of a camp; and
- associated abandonment and reclamation.

Dominion will also be applying to obtain permission for the activities of large diameter drilling and/or Trenching to achieve up to 1,200 tonnes of bulk sample material, use and storage of explosives (<500 kg) for trenching, expansion of the main camp and for exploration camp(s) on the property as well as winter road to access the property.
