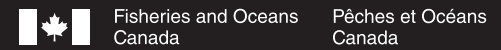

NOTICE OF PROPOSED WORK

Wharf Rehabilitation Hay River, NT

Fisheries and Oceans Canada is planning work at the Hay River (East Channel) Harbour from June 15 to September 30, 2019. The exact timeline depends on water levels and a successful tendering process.

Temporary access to the floating wharves will be provided for the duration of the project. The area to the west of the existing concrete deck will be closed to the general public.

The work includes: extending the concrete deck along the steel sheet pile marginal wharf to the west end of the property; and, installing a new wheel guard and mooring bollards.

Wharf Rehabilitation Moraine Bay, NT

Fisheries and Oceans Canada is planning work at the Moraine Bay Harbour from June 15 to September 15, 2019. The exact timeline depends on ice conditions, water levels, and a successful tendering process.

The wharf will be closed to the general public during construction.

The project includes: repairing the steel and crib structures, and replacing the wharf timber and decking.

TUNGSTEN OPPORTUNITY REQUEST FOR EXPRESSIONS OF INTEREST ("RFEI")

On behalf of the Government of Canada and the Government of the Northwest Territories, Alvarez & Marsal Canada Inc. as Court-appointed Monitor (the "Monitor") of North American Tungsten Corporation Ltd. ("NATC") is seeking expressions of interest from interested parties relating to the purchase and/or investment in two tungsten assets: the Cantung Mine site and the Mactung deposit (jointly, the "Assets"). NATC is the owner of the Cantung tungsten mine which ceased operating in October 2015 and is currently under care and maintenance. The mine is located in the south-west corner of the Northwest Territories and is fully permitted with a valid water licence until January 2024.
