Good afternoon,

On behalf of the Northwest Territories Power Corporation, I would like to inform you that construction of the Taltson Winter Road will begin on Wednesday January 8, 2020. Access to the road will be radio-controlled and will be open to designated work crews only during construction. To ensure the safety of all parties, the public is advised to stay off of the route during construction. The route of the Taltson Winter Road is shown in Figure 1 (attached).

Construction and use of the road is authorized by Mackenzie Valley Land and Water Board Type B Water Licence MV2019L8-0008 and Type A Land Use Permit MV2019F0015.

When construction of the road is nearing completion, you will be notified by email.
