The Mackenzie Valley Land and Water Board (MVLWB or the Board) received your Application dated June 28, 2019 for a Land Use Permit on June 28, 2019. Your Application has been reviewed and found to be lacking sufficient information to conduct a preliminary screening as per paragraph 22(1)(a) of the Mackenzie Valley Land Use Regulations (MVLUR). In order for this Application to be considered complete and forwarded for review, the following information must be submitted to our office:

1. A copy of your current Certificate of Corporate Registration from the Government of the Northwest Territories.
2. A letter from the Tungsten Facility confirming they will accept wastes from your activities for off-site disposal as described in your Waste Management Plan. If the letter is not forthcoming, please provide evidence that attempts were made to obtain the letter.
3. An Engagement Plan, including an Engagement Log, which includes copies of all correspondence and minutes of all meetings held between yourselves and communities and Aboriginal groups and First Nations organizations

4. An application fee of \$150.00, made out to the **Receiver General for Canada**.
5. Board staff encourage you to use the attached worksheet to calculate and provide a closure and reclamation cost estimate for the activities described in your application.


Board staff would like to extend an offer to you to further discuss the information requirements at your convenience.
