NOTICE OF REVISED PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD Bathurst Caribou Herd

On January 22, 2019, the Tłı̨chǫ Government (TG) and Department of Environment & Natural Resources (ENR), Government of Northwest Territories submitted the "Joint Proposal on Management Actions for the Bathurst ʔekwó (Barren-ground caribou) Herd 2019-2021" to the Wek'èezhì Renewable Resources Board (WRRB) outlining proposed management actions for the Bathurst Caribou Herd in Wek'èezhì (Joint Management Proposal). The WRRB requested parties to provide written comments on the Joint Management Proposal by March 15, 2019.

Following receipt of the Minister of ENR's February 26, 2019 letter, which requests parties on the distribution list to provide written comments on the Joint Management Proposal by April 5, 2019, the WRRB has decided to extend its public comment period. **Anyone interested in providing comments to the WRRB on the Joint Management Proposal may do so in writing through email or fax by no later than 5:00 p.m. MDT on April 5, 2019. This proposal can be viewed on the Public Registry at www.wrrb.ca.**

The WRRB further requests that ENR provide a compilation of any comments received by it by no later than 5:00 p.m. MDT on April 10, 2019. Following the public comment period, the WRRB will review the Joint Management Proposal during its next board meeting, tentatively scheduled for late April 2019, and make recommendations on the proposed management actions.
