



## Snow Disposal Plan

The Snow Disposal plan for the Town of Hay River consists of 3 major areas within the Town that snow is hauled to during winter clearing of the Down Town Core as well as residential streets. Our snow clearing equipment consists of a grader to windrow snow and ice to the centre of the street which is then loaded onto trucks with a snow blower, our loader follows to clean up any areas that are not grader accessible. Streets that do not have concrete curb and gutter, including the Old Town and West Channel areas, are cleared by plowing snow along ditch lines for the season.

The following areas are used as snow dump sites:

### Site #1 on Tamarack Drive

- 60°48'39.08N/115°48'18.13W/Elevation 164m
- approximate area 16,900 square meters
- approximate yearly quantity 8000 cubic meters
- this area is flat with a swale running northwest to existing drainage ditch
- this area is also used for clay stockpiles of native materials
- snow from the down town core is hauled to this site

### Site #2 on Highway #2

- 60°47'13.73N/115°49'34.03W/Elevation 170m
- approximate area 7800 square meters
- approximate yearly quantity 4500 cubic meters
- this area is flat with natural drainage to the south east as well a local ditch
- snow from the south end of town is hauled to this site

**Site #3 Cedar Rd.**

- 60°49'19.72N/115°47'26.95W/Elevation 160m
- approximate area 7500 square meters
- approximate yearly quantity 6000 cubic meters
- this is a flat area with a drainage ditch to the southwest
- snow from the north end of town is hauled here
