Land Use Permit Application – Incomplete
North American Tungsten Corporation Ltd. - Geotechnical – Tungsten, NT

The Mackenzie Valley Land and Water Board (MVLWB or the Board) received your application dated April 12, 2019 for a Land Use Permit on April 15, 2019. Your application has been reviewed and found to be lacking sufficient information to conduct a preliminary screening as per paragraph 22(1)(a) of the Mackenzie Valley Land Use Regulations (MVLUR). In order for this Application to be considered complete and forwarded for review, the following information must be submitted to our office:

1. An application fee of \$150.00, made out to the **Receiver General for Canada**.
2. Land-use fees: If more than two hectares of federal public lands are being used, enter the number of hectares in excess of the two hectares included in the Application fee, rounded up to the next whole hectare.
3. While it will not affect completeness of the application, Board staff encourage you to use the attached worksheet to calculate and provide a closure and reclamation cost estimate for the activities described in your application. Board staff will provide the Board with an estimate prepared using the same worksheet; it is helpful to have the company's opinion on closure costs for the Board's decision making.

Board staff would like to extend an offer to you to further discuss the information requirements at your convenience.

Upon receipt of this information, the Application will be reviewed in accordance with the *Mackenzie Valley Resource Management Act*. For further assistance, please refer to "Guide To Completing Land Use Permit Applications to the Mackenzie Valley Land and Water Board" available on our website at www.mvlwb.com under "Apply for Permit/Licence" and "Forms and Guides".

If this supplementary information is not provided within ninety (90) days, then it shall be assumed that you do not wish to continue with the processing of this application, and the Application will be returned to you as per Section 25 of the MVLUR. Any land use fees that have been paid with submission of the Application will be refunded to you by the Department of Aboriginal Affairs and Northern Development Canada.
