Regarding your letter dated May 14, 2020 I am resolving the incomplete application items identified and they are as follows:

1. Engagement Record and Plan is underway and attached.
2. The maximum number of persons anticipated to occupy project site simultaneously during work hours is five (5). This will include a Supervisor, a bulldozer operator, a loader operator and 2 haul truck drivers.
3. The estimated quantities of wastes that will be generated will be limited to one garbage bag of waste similar to household garbage with non-contaminated waste. A letter of authorization is attached.
4. A cost estimate for closure and reclamation for the site is attached.
5. There will be no sewage generated at the site as the crew will only be on site to extract sand and return to Fort Simpson. Should there be a requirement, Nogha has porta-potties that can be placed on-site for temporary use.
6. A copy of a legible and appropriately scaled map is attached. There will be no infrastructure, there are no nearby water bodies, spill kits will be stored in the back of pick-up trucks and equipment.
7. Please see the attached Spill Containment Plan KM 486, Hwy#1.
8. Please see the attached Nogha Enterprises Quarry Operational Plan 2020 and the Nogha Enterprises Ltd Pit Development Plan.
9. I will need assistance with the Template for Environmental and Resource Impacts and Mitigation Measures Information. Not sure where to find this.
