<b>Item Description:</b>	<p>The SLWB has received the 2015 Annual Summer Inspection Reports in accordance with the reporting requirements of Water Licence <a href="#">S03L1-016</a>. Although the reports do not require formal Board approval, the purpose of this review is to consider the progress made on closure of the Project Site as well as whether the results and conclusions have been appropriately and accurately reported and support the recommended further remediation and reclamation activities.</p> <p>This Type B Water Licence was issued on December 13, 2003 for a period of five years, with a renewal to December 12, 2010, and is now expired but not closed. The Licence was for winter exploratory oil and gas drilling of three wells approximately 50-70km south of Colville Lake. The associated Land Use Permit is <a href="#">S03A-008</a> and is also expired but not closed.</p>
