
After careful review of the applications for a Land Use Permit and a Water Licence to conduct a winter drilling project at Nogha/Tunago Lakes, our staff are satisfied with your responses to our list of deficiencies received October 30, 2003, and now consider the applications as being **Deemed Complete**. Some additional information as outlined below, should be addressed is to ensure that the applications can be processed expeditiously within the 42 day period.

1. The Community Consultation in the applications did not identify how Apache Canada Ltd. (ACL) will gain access from Fort Good Hope to Colville Lake. ACL should notify the pertinent individuals and organizations involved in the original project consultations, by means of a letter(s), to give notice of the details of what option(s) ACL is utilizing to gain access from Fort Good Hope to Colville Lake. The SLWB requires a copy of such letter(s) for our Public Registry.
2. ACL needs to secure a letter from Paramount Resources Ltd. reference the assignment of the S02B-006 Land Use Permit to ACL. Timing is critical, as this
