**Re: Assignment – Land Use Permit S03A-008 / Water Licence S03L1-016
Oil and Gas Exploration - Nogha/Tunago Settlement Lands - West Nogha K-14, Nogha B-23, North
Tunago E-44 wellsites Colville Lake area, NT**

On September 26, 2018, the Sahtu Land and Water Board (SLWB, or Board) considered your Application for an assignment of Land Use Permit (Permit) S03A-008 and associated Water Licence (Licence) S03L1-016 from Apache Canada Ltd. to MGM Energy.

Pursuant to section 38 of the *Mackenzie Valley Land Use Regulations* (MVLUR), the Board has approved the assignment of Permit S03A-008. Pursuant to section 39 of the *Waters Act* and section 9 of the *Waters Regulations* the Board has approved the assignment of Licence S03L1-016.

Please note, that the terms and conditions of the original Permit and Licence have not been updated to reflect current legislation and contact information as the terms of the Permit and Licence have expired.

Sub-section 29 (6) of the MVLUR states that “notwithstanding the expiration or cancellation of a permit, the submission of a final plan or the giving of a notice of discontinuance under section 37, a permittee remains responsible for all obligations arising under the permit or under these Regulations until such time as the Board issues a letter of clearance pursuant to section 33”. Therefore, the MVLUR provide for the remediation obligations and liability of a permit holder to extend beyond the expiry of the permit.

Licences issued under the *Waters Act* include remediation. The Licences include ‘abandonment and restoration’ provisions. In fulfilling all obligations under a licence, the licence holder is required to abandon and restore the site.

A copy of this Licence and Permit has been filed on the Public Registry at the SLWB office. Please be advised that this letter, with its attached procedures, inspection reports, and related correspondence is part of the Public Registry and is intended to keep all interested parties informed of the manner in which the Licence and Permit requirements are being met.
