Hi Bruce

Re: W/Ls S03L1-015, S03L1-016, LUPs S03A-007, S03A-008

I will pass this request on to the proponent but the Sahtu Land and Water Board does not require this information to consider the extension of the land use permits or the renewal of the water licences. In regards to a water licence and land use permit, the terms and conditions of both do not change with the extension/renewal and if the proponent (Apache) intends to do any work not covered by the original application, and this includes any references to camps, they will be required to submit a new application for water licence and land use permit. The Apache extensions and renewals are to extend the expiry dates as the majority of work outlined in the original applications (drilling, access, etc.) has already occurred.

In general, the remaining work to be done on-site and which may go ahead without the renewal/extension, are reclamation and restoration. Even though the W/L and the LUP have expired (not regarding the extension/renewal application), items such as reclamation and restoration are still the responsibility of the proponent and are covered under existing licences and permits barring the triggering of a new land use permit or water licence.
