With respect to the letter from ENR

1. As discussed, the terms and conditions specified the preparation of a monitoring plan, not the specifics of groundwater mapping.
2. Husky has initiated this program voluntarily for its own programs and will make the data available for public review. We cannot commit to integrating this information into other operators plans, nor is there any guarantee that information from other operators will be incorporated.
3. The monitoring plan will collect information from the existing network. If the network grows in the future, the data that is collected from the monitoring program could be used in a groundwater mapping project. However, a regional mapping program should not be a mandate for any individual oil and gas operator.
4. We believe that the data to be collected by Husky and the adjacent operator to be similar and will be suitable for comparison purposes.
