The Sahtu Land and Water Board (SLWB or Board) met on January 23, 2019 to consider the documents submitted on December 6, 2018 as required to provide an update of all relevant Project documents for the 2019 Slater River Abandonment Program in accordance with the conditions of Water Licence S13L1-005 and Land Use Permit S13A-002. As per the conditions:

- An updated Waste Management Plan was required by S13L1-005 Part D condition 2 and S13A-002 condition 37;
- A Closure and Reclamation Plan was required by S13A-002 condition 65.

The Board hereby approves the updated Waste Management Plan.

The Board hereby approves the Interim Closure and Reclamation Plan with the direction that the Plan be revised and further developed in one year to include component specific long-term schedules and other changes based on monitoring, inspections, and seasonal changes.

This letter, all Inspection Reports, and correspondence related thereto is part of the Public Registry and is intended to keep all interested parties informed of the manner in which the Permit and Licence requirements are being met.
