Imperial Oil Resources N.W.T. Limited (Imperial) received a letter on September 29, 2018 from the Sahtu Land and Water Board (SLWB) informing Imperial that the Board agreed that there is sufficient time to conduct a 3rd party review of the Norman Wells Aquatic Effects Monitoring Program (AEMP). The SLWB also noted that it is their expectation that Imperial would choose a third party expert in aquatic investigations to be approved by the board.

Imperial would like to submit Dr. Kelly Munkittrick, Executive Director of Cold Regions and Water initiatives at Wilfrid Laurier University as a candidate for the third party review and workshop facilitator. It is Imperial's understanding that Dr. Munkittrick is currently working on various projects in the Northwest Territories around aquatic effects and cumulative effects monitoring. This along with his reputation as an expert in the field of aquatic investigations would make him a good fit to review the Norman Wells AEMP.
