Hi Paul,

As per my voicemail as of yesterday Imperial has safely ceased production at the Norman Wells operation as a result of the closure of Enbridge's Line 21 pipeline, the only available transportation option for oil produced at the site. During the shutdown period, we will continue to preserve and maintain equipment and facilities to enable a future startup of the operation.

We continue to work with Enbridge to determine the scope and timelines of its plan for the pipeline at the Mackenzie River crossing, including any remediation or mitigation work. Updates on Enbridge's activities on Line 21 can be found [here](#).

We have notified Northwest Territories Power Corporation (NTPC) of the planned shutdown of the Norman Wells operation and we are working with NTPC as it transitions to providing power for the community.

As always, our first priority is to ensure the safety of our workforce and community. Imperial will continue to provide updates to employees and community stakeholders about the situation.
