An update on yesterday's incident initial report. Imperial continues to respond to the incident at its Norman Wells facility. The fire was extinguished overnight on Friday and is now out. Our focus remains on the safety of our employees, our contractors and our neighbours in the community.

Residents can expect to see additional flaring and black smoke from the facility as our response efforts continue. We appreciate the continued cooperation of the community to stay clear of the site for their safety and that of our responders. We are working to reset the emergency alarm sounding from one of our cross-river facilities. We apologize for any disruption or inconvenience that this incident has caused the community.

We greatly appreciate the support of the town's fire department who responded quickly and provided standby support Friday evening.
