Good day Mr. Antony and Mr. Huebner,

I wanted to take the opportunity to introduce myself as the Regulatory Specialist that is responsible for the coordination of files associated with the Water Licence [S13L8-003](#) held by Mackenzie Valley Environmental Contractors Ltd. I have

recently updated the Public Registry to include a Site Inspection Report and wanted to send along a reminder that the Board has not been in receipt of an Annual Report since the Licence was issued. Annual Reports are required as part of the Terms and Conditions of the WL (Part B, Item 2) and were due March 31st, 2014 and each year thereafter for the term of the Licence. The details which should be included (from the WL) are:

- a.) the monthly and annual quantities in cubic metres of all effluent discharged from the sumps;
- b.) a summary of modifications and/or major maintenance work carried out on the Hydrocarbon Land Treatment Facility;
- c.) tabular summaries of all data generated under the "Surveillance Network Program";
- d.) the details and results of the Groundwater Monitoring Plan, including but not limited to; monitoring locations (GPS coordinates), depths, frequency of monitoring events, flow direction, chemical parameters tested, and data analysis;
- e.) volume and analytical results of soil accepted and of treated soil removed from the Hydrocarbon Land Treatment Facility. Analytical results must include soil chemistry and soil particle size;
- f.) a list of unauthorized discharges;
- g.) any revisions to the approved Spill Contingency Plan;
- h.) any revisions to the approved Operations and Maintenance Plans;
- i.) the details of any reclamation including progressive reclamation; and
- j.) any other details on waste disposal requested by the Sahtu Land and Water Board by November 1st of the year being reported.

I trust we will be receiving an update in the near future.
