

## Husky Oil Operations Ltd. – SLATER RIVER PROJECT

Please note that the Husky NWT Emergency Response Plan (ERP) and Spill Contingency Plan (SCP) is on file with the Sahtu Land and Water Board (SLWB) which was most recently submitted with the O-41 and G-70 Vertical Well Drilling and Completions Program application (S13A-002 and S13L1-005) with site specific sections for the Slater River and Summit Creek programs. With each subsequent new or amended application to the SLWB, Husky will submit a letter confirming if there are any updates to the ERP and SCP for that particular application, and if there are, the updated sections will be submitted to the SLWB. Husky has no updates at this time for the Site Wide Services application.

### Emergency Response and Spill Contingency Plan

The documents found in this section of the application binder are the NWT Emergency Response Plan and Spill Contingency Plan, with site specific sections for Slater River and Summit Creek.

The NWT Emergency Response Plan and Spill Contingency documents are updated annually with updates to critical information being updated in a timely matter, which may include an update package.

These documents are active documents that will be updated as further site specific information is gathered. Presently the Husky NWT Emergency Response Plan and Spill Contingency Plan are being updated to indicate the most current information that pertains to the 2013 summer operations. This course of updates currently entails the following scope:

- Updates to the existing corporate phone lists

#### Section 3.2

- Confirm emergency services contact list

#### Section 3.3

- Confirm government contacts

#### Section 3.4

- Updates to support services and corresponding contact information

#### Section 3.5

- Updating the distribution list

### Section 4.0 – Site Section Development & Updates

- Development of the G70 and O41 site specific documentation as well as mapping for these locations
- Mapping of new and changed access routes
- Mapping development of newly constructed airstrip and staging area
- Confirming medical evacuation procedures in plan
- Updates to the hazardous materials list
- Verifying and updating the spill points locations
- Update all equipment lists
- Revise notification process to indicate updated corporate personnel
- Inserting Environment Canada information in plan
- Updating the project communication network once radio frequencies become available

Many of the updates noted above are contingent on information being provided to H<sub>2</sub>Safety Services to see the project to completion and distribution of new binders.
