**Re: Issuance of Type “A” Land Use Permit and Type “B” Water Licence
Tweed Lake M-47 Well Re-suspension, K’asho Got’ine District, Sahtu Settlement
Area, Northwest Territories**

We have attached Land Use Permit S14A-006 and Water Licence S14L1-004 granted by the Sahtu Land and Water Board (SLWB) in accordance with the *Mackenzie Valley Resource Management Act* and the *Waters Act*. This Permit and Licence has been approved for a period of five years commencing November 17, 2014 and expiring November 16, 2019.

We have attached conditions, and note that in accordance with Land Use Permit condition Part C, Item 30, a security deposit in the amount of \$24,145.31 and in accordance with the Water Licence condition Part B, Item 9 a security deposit in the amount of \$43,734.00 shall be posted with the Minister and copied to the SLWB prior to the start of the operation pursuant to section 32 of the *Mackenzie Valley Land Use Regulations* and section 35 of the *Waters Act*.

The SLWB would like to remind and request Suncor of the following:

- As per Government of the Northwest Territories – Environment and Natural Resources (GNWT-ENR) recommendation, obtain an approval from the community solid waste disposal facility for domestic waste disposal prior to the commencement of operations. A letter from the community approving such deposits must be submitted to the Board.
- To register Suncor as a hazardous waste generator with the GNWT-ENR prior to the commencement of operations.
- To obtain and submit to the Board a letter from Tervita confirming that hazardous down-hole waste recovered during the Program will be contained and disposed of at its landfill facility in Rainbow Lake, AB.

- To maintain a water log for the withdrawal of water from the approved source (i.e., Colville Lake) during the entire Program. The water withdrawal log shall be submitted to the Board as part of the annual reporting requirements.

Copies of this Permit and Licence have been filed on the Public Registry at the office of the SLWB. This letter, all Inspection Reports, and correspondence related thereto is part of the Public Registry and is intended to keep all interested parties informed of the manner in which the Permit and Licence requirements are being met.
