

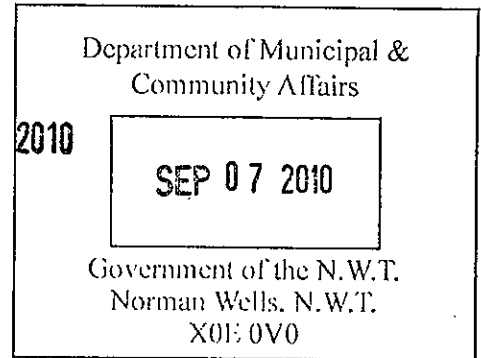

Reservation by Notation for Mackenzie Valley Highway

This will respond to your letter dated August 20, 2010, requesting that the Department of Municipal and Community Affairs (MACA) establish a Reservation by Notation for the portion of the proposed Mackenzie Valley Highway that passes through the Norman Wells' Block Land Transfer Area.

I am pleased to confirm that Reservation by Notation No. R10-03066 has been established in favour of the Department of Transportation for the purpose of setting aside a one kilometre wide right-of-way for the proposed Mackenzie Valley Highway, where it passes through the Norman Wells' Block Land Transfer Area. This Reservation by Notation applies to the land identified on the attached map.

The Reservation by Notation will remain in place until such time as this office is advised by the Department of Transportation that it is no longer required, but in any event will remain in place until September 2020. 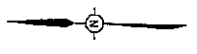


Norman Wells
