### **Name And Contact Information For Site First Aid**

First Aid will be provided by personnel on site, who have valid First Aid certification, for initial treatment. This person will be designated daily during the morning tool box talk and will be documented in the meeting minutes and on the FLRA's or THA for that day. In the unlikely event no personnel on site have First Aid the supervisors on shift will be designated and contact can be made with them by cell phone or radio. This will determine if further assessment is required by medical personnel at the Monica Loomis Health Centre in Norman Wells. The Health Centre is located approximately three (3) kilometers from the site work area.

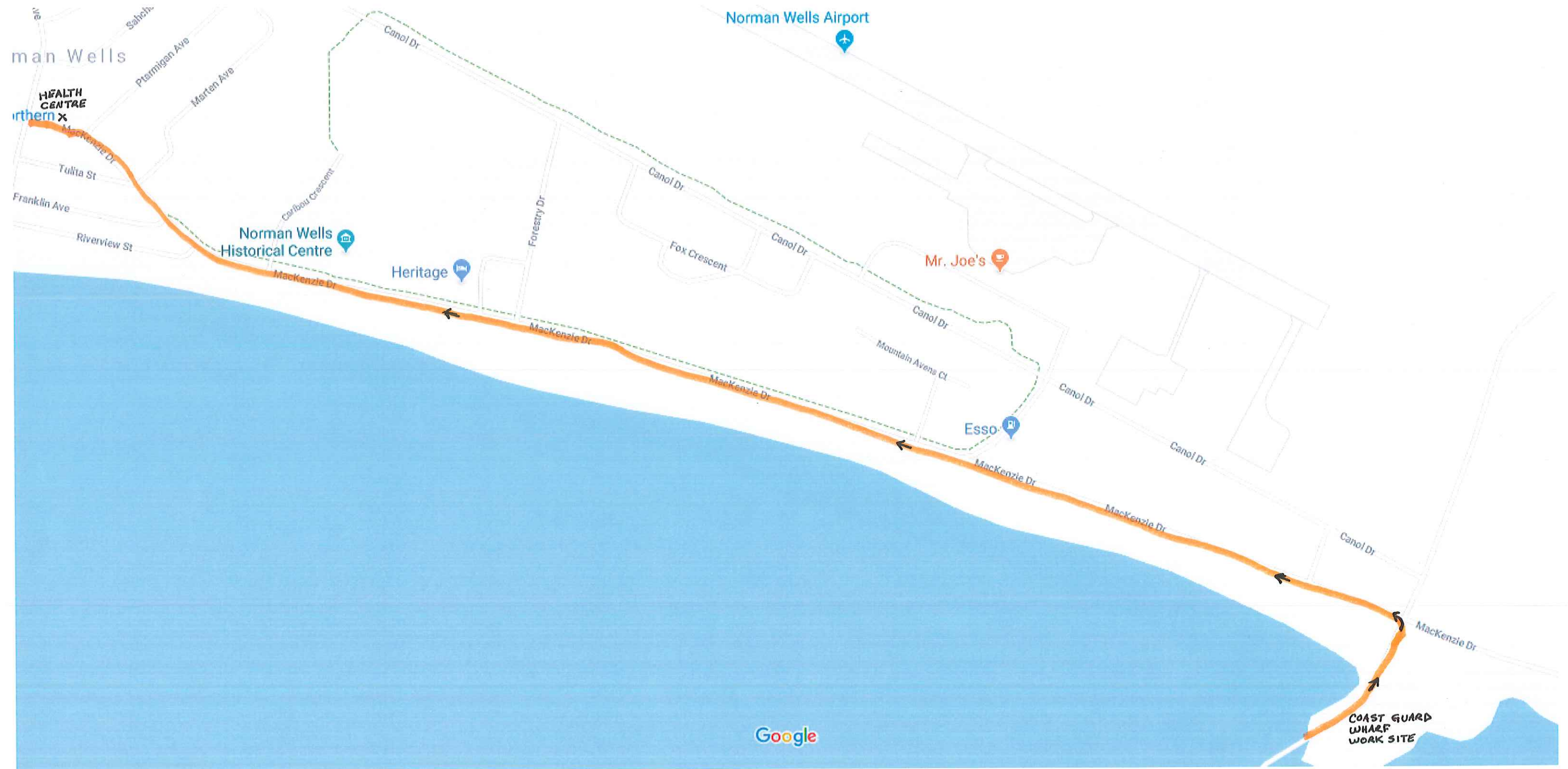
### **Worksite Signage, Fencing or Barricades**

The entire work area will be surrounded by a snow berm built as the area is being cleared of snow and rubble ice. As well there will be lathes embedded into the top of the berm. These lathes will be drilled to allow for a ¼" rope to be threaded through them. The rope will be identified using warning ribbon tied to it for better visibility. Also, signs will be posted at the East and West end of the work area to warn the public of the hazard. Signs will read "DANGER OPEN WATER".

### **Working Near Open Water or Dock Edge**

Any personnel that are required to be closer than three (3) meters or ten (10) feet of the dock edge or open water will be required to wear a five point harness with a twenty (20) foot lifeline attached and a PFD. The lifeline must be manned by another worker in case of a fall.
