Re: Approval of updated Waste Management Plan and Spill Contingency Plan for Water Licence S16L8-002 for repair to Canadian Coast Guard Wharf in Norman Wells, NT

The Board met on February 28, 2018 to consider the additional documents submitted to the SLWB as required in the issuance letter dated April 19, 2017 for the Type B Water Licence S16L8-002. As outlined in the conditions, the Board required the following:

- Part D, item 2: Prior to the commencement of activities, the Licensee shall submit to the Board, for approval, a revised Waste Management Plan. The Plan shall be prepared in accordance with the MVLWB *Guidelines for Developing a Waste Management Plan*.
- Part F, item 1: Prior to the commencement of activities, the Licensee shall submit to the Board, for approval, a Spill Contingency Plan. The Plan shall be in accordance with INAC's *Guidelines for Spill Contingency Planning*.
- Part D, item 4: The Licensee shall obtain written permission from the Town of Norman Wells to dispose of waste materials at the landfill.
- The Licensee provide the Board with a list of equipment to be used and any fuel storage once the contractor has been selected.

The Board has received the following items and distributed them for review. Upon careful consideration of comments and recommendations received and proponent responses to these comments, any other evidence received during the review period, the Board is satisfied that the submitted **Waste Management Plan** meets all requirements for approval. The Board hereby requires that DFO resubmit the **Spill Contingency Plan** in accordance with comments made during the review, as summarized in the Table below. This Plan will be considered to be approved upon written confirmation of conformity from Board staff.
