### **Issuance of Type B Water Licence Repair to Canadian Coast Guard Wharf in Norman Wells, NT**

Attached is Type B Water Licence S16L8-002 granted by the Sahtu Land and Water Board (SLWB or Board) in accordance with the *Mackenzie Valley Resource Management Act* and the *Waters Act*. Water Licence S16L8-002 has been approved for a period of two years commencing April 19, 2017 and expiring April 18, 2019.

As outlined in the conditions of the Water Licence S16L8-002, the Board requires the following:

- Part B, item 6: Prior to the commencement of activities, the Licensee shall submit to the Board, for approval, a revised Environmental Management Plan.
- Part D, item 2: Prior to the commencement of activities, the Licensee shall submit to the Board, for approval, a revised Waste Management Plan. The Plan shall be prepared in accordance with the MVLWB *Guidelines for Developing a Waste Management Plan*.
- Part F, item 1: Prior to the commencement of activities, the Licensee shall submit to the Board, for approval, a Spill Contingency Plan. The Plan shall be in accordance with INAC's *Guidelines for Spill Contingency Planning*.
- Part G, item 1: The Licensee shall submit to the Board, for approval, a Sediment and Erosion Control Plan no later than 60 days prior to commencing operating. This Plan shall be in accordance with Schedule 2.
- Part D, item 4: The Licensee shall obtain written permission from the Town of Norman Wells to dispose of waste materials at the landfill.
- Part D, item 6: Prior to the deposit of Waste at a waste facility, an Inspector's written verification of the facility's Water Licence compliance and capacity from an Inspector must be submitted to the Board.

The Board also requires the following:

- The Licensee must obtain written Inspector permission to undertake the proposed activity without a Land Use Permit to satisfy section 6b of the *Mackenzie Valley Land Use Regulations*; and
- The Licensee provide the Board with a list of equipment to be used and any fuel storage once the contractor has been selected.

Should you wish to cancel this Licence at any time prior to the date of completion set out in the Licence, a written notice of cancellation is required as per section 10 of the *Waters Regulations*.

A copy of this Licence has been filed on the Public Registry at the SLWB office. Please be advised that this letter, with its attached procedures, inspection reports, and related correspondence is part of the Public Registry and is intended to keep all interested parties informed of the manner in which the Licence requirements are being met.
