**RE: Installation of new groundwater monitoring wells at the Norman Wells Airport, Land Treatment Unit – Application for a Land Use Permit**

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Transport Canada plans to install three groundwater monitoring wells near an existing Land Treatment Unit (LTU) at the, the Norman Wells Airport. Installation of new monitoring wells will require the use of power-driven, earth-drilling machinery within airport boundaries. Installation of monitoring wells requires a Land Use Permit under the Mackenzie Valley Land Use Regulations, which has a requirement for engagement. The three new monitoring wells will be installed in the same general locations as three existing original monitoring wells requiring replacement. Installation is scheduled November 2017, once all permits are received. The groundwater wells are required to monitor groundwater quality and assess the integrity of the Land Treatment Unit.

A map outlining the location of proposed monitoring wells is attached for your reference.
