**Re: Land Use Permit Application – S18X-004
Oscar Creek Bridge Relocation Geotechnical Investigation and Right of Way Clearing –Tulita District
Deemed Complete**

The application (dated November 16, 2018) for a Land Use Permit for the geotechnical study in the Tulita District has been "**Deemed Complete**", as per section 22 of the *Mackenzie Valley Land Use Regulations*, today. We will circulate the application to review organizations and complete a Preliminary Environmental Screening upon receipt of responses from these organizations. Additional information may be required during the review process.

Following review of the LUP application, within 42 days of the date of this letter, the SLWB will take one of the following actions:

1. Issue a Type A permit, subject to any conditions included under subsection 26(1) of the MVLUR;
2. Order, under section 24 of the MVRMA, that a hearing be held or further studies or investigations be made respecting the lands proposed to be used in the land use operation;
3. Refer the application to the Mackenzie Valley Environmental Impact Review Board for an environmental assessment under subsection 125(1) of the MVRMA; or
4. Where a requirement set out in section 61 or 62 of the MVRMA has not been met, refuse to issue a permit.
