**Issuance of Type A Land Use Permit
Geotechnical Investigation and Right-of-way Clearing at Oscar Creek Bridge, Mackenzie Valley Winter Road, Sahtu Region, NT**

Attached is Type A Land Use Permit S18X-004 granted by the Sahtu Land and Water Board (SLWB or Board) on January 10, 2019, in accordance with the *Mackenzie Valley Resource Management Act* and the *Mackenzie Valley Land Use Regulations*. Land Use Permit S18X-004 has been approved for a period of two years commencing January 11, 2019 and expiring on March 31, 2021. Please read all conditions carefully.

The Board considered the requirement for a Water Licence associated with this Project as water use for the winter road construction and pad for the camp may potentially exceed the threshold of 100 cubic metres per day. The Board has accepted the Applicant's submission that daily water use will remain below this threshold; however, direct the GNWT-INF to maintain a log of all water use from all sources throughout the duration of the Project and submit these records to the Board and the Water Resource Inspector as requested or at the end of the Project.

Should you wish to discontinue your land use operation at any time prior to the date of completion set out in this Permit, a written notice of discontinuance is required as per section 37 of the *Mackenzie Valley Land Use Regulations*, in addition to the submission of a final plan.

A copy of this Permit has been filed on the Public Registry at the SLWB office. Please be advised that this letter, with its attached procedures, inspection reports, and related correspondence is part of the Public Registry and is intended to keep all interested parties informed of the manner in which the Permit requirements are being met.
