Hi Clint,

Thanks for the report. Saddened to hear about the fuel leaks, especially the building barrel leak – I understood that all these barrels had been disconnected and 'made safe' as we had a leak in a similar previous episode. If I can get someone to go in sooner than later as I mention below to rectify the spills, I will.

Had you inspected the camp in 2013? Can you resend as I don't seem to have an inspection report on file but possibly I missed it?

Yes we will address the issues and plan to visit the site late summer/early fall (Aug-Sept) or sooner. We are in discussions with a potential partner who would plan and anticipate a winter program and we would conduct a site visit as part of the due diligence and at that time, bucket and remove the contaminated soil and rectify ongoing leakage. We will work closely with a partner to ensure the issues in your inspection report are addressed as soon as possible and will keep you informed as to our progress.

The bulk of the fuel was purchased in Mar 2009 and taken in on the winter road as we had anticipated a summer program following. Unforeseen circumstances and the up til now downturn in diamond exploration interest didn't allow adequate funding for the planned programs. There are untested kimberlites remaining to be tested and the bulk of the inventory and supplies will be utilized in the next program. The upcoming trip will include inventory listing to determine the feasibility and necessity for a spur ice road from the road camp. If supplies are taken in by winter road, the empty barrels and other unneeded items (and debris) will be sent return on the truck along with some larger kimberlite samples awaiting analyses. If no winter ice road is necessary, twin otter (flights) backhauls will be utilized. The economics will dictate which method of transport will be used.

Your pictures provide good coverage and would you be able to send me the original digital pictures so I can use them for close-ups? This would provide us advance information prior to our visit. We regularly use Hightail for sending larger files.

I've been out of touch as to your office and persons – other inspectors copied. I understand exploration has picked up and you might be busier now than the previous few years. Its great we have interest in the Monument and re-visiting the data files again is exciting for potential kimberlites and re-visiting previous targets we had forgotten. I have not been well as they only discovered (over 3 years) a broken vertebrae in my middle back. I am still in extensive physiotherapy after having a laminectomy on 4 vertabrae which allowed the spinal cord and torso nerves to re-align. It will be a lengthy heal but am so grateful I can walk now which is better than before. It was a gradual loss of limb and lower back damage (of long ago) masked the current problem. So that's what I'm up to right now and counting on this potential partner to take the Monument project to the next level. Stu and Chris are still involved and supportive of a partner to provide necessary funding and conduct the programs.
