Good afternoon Marty and Luke,

Thanks for a productive conversation regarding the closure of Panda/Koala Underground Mines. Based on our discussions, staff understand the following:

- The Inspector is receiving daily decommissioning reports from Dominion which describe the reclamation activities to be completed each day;
- The inspector will be provided weekly updates of the infrastructure removed and that remaining underground;
- The Inspector has increased the inspections of Panda/Koala Underground Mines from a monthly to weekly frequency;
- The inspector will continue to provide monthly Inspection Reports to the Board (e.g., [December 2018](#) and [January 2019](#) Reports);
- The Inspector will continue to work with Dominion to ensure the reclamation activities are in accordance with the approved [ICRP Version 2.4](#) and its approved closure objectives for Underground Mines (PDF pg. 493-494); and
- Dominion will provide a Reclamation Completion Report to the Board for approval following closure, in accordance with the Boards' Closure Guidelines.

Please review the process described above and respond to this e-mail confirming whether it is accurate.
