
Hello Sarah

This statement was made in the context of the risk for PK/minewater to flow out of the LCLF and towards the lake located west of Cell A. This risk is mitigated through regular LLCFs inspection and monitoring of the PK and minewater elevations. Relatively speaking the risk to lose containment of PK/minewater is much lower within central/lower areas of Cells A and C (see below sketch)
