Hello Clint,

The Wek'èezhii Land and Water Board has received a two-year extension [request](#) from Adamera Minerals Corp. (Adamera) to continue with its Hepburn Lake land use operation. The current permit, [W2015C0002](#), expires March 25, 2020.

Board staff have identified that the mineral claims for this project are no longer active; however, understand that an extension to this Permit is required to continue with final clean-up and restoration. The proponent has identified in its extension request that it would like to continue with

the exploration work. In a phone call with Graham Gill (the individual who submitted the request), it was indicated that the company will be looking to re-activate claims in the coming year.

As the landowner for the permitted area, can the GNWT Department of Lands indicate in writing whether they believe the eligibility requirements set out in Section 18 of the Land Use Regulations have been satisfied? It would be greatly appreciated if a response could be provided by end-of-day on Wednesday, February 12, 2020.
