Hello Clint and Joe,

With regards to Land Use Permit W2015C0008, camp occupation of Credit Lake camp, this memo is to inform that de-mob and camp shut down is planned for Sunday May 8th.

Currently the camp is being cleaned and prepared for shut down. Upon demob all fuel tanks behind tents and buildings will be shut off and bungs tightened. Fresh diapers will be placed on valves and any hoses that weak at the joints will be cut back and re-attached securly. Several have already been done after the previous inspection and no longer are moist with fuel.

During clean up after the last inspection one drum that had been placed with those 4 mixed fuel drums out infront of the heli pad showed yellow spotting on the snow. It was not noted during inspection so it may have developed once the weather had warmed up. It had only been placed there a few weeks before. The source was a pin hole in a crease at the bung. The snow was removed and cleaned as per the melt and skim method. The drum was near full when discovered but an amount of diesel did make it to the frozen soil. This was chipped out and the contaminated soil was placed in 2 plastic garbage cans and shipped to Yellowknife for remediation. The drum was imediately emptied and also sent out on a backhaul. The 4 mixed fuel drums were moved up onto the outcrop beside the helipad. These were not affected and we're checked for integraty before being moved.

Photos of camp shut down are being taken and will be forwarded on to you.

Thank you the inspection report W2015C0008, camp use. The crew has attended to the concerns noted and continues to clean up camp in anticipation of the project completion.

Fuel slops on the snow were removed and the snow melted and fuel skimmed off with environmental cloth. The Blue trap was removed that afternoon and the remaining tarps that were showing tears (mainly the one on the large logging shack) have also been cleaned up. These were removed form site to Yellowknife for proper disposal. Latrine capacity has also been monitored and with warming weather the frozen waste has started melting and settling down into the sump built at the last camp use in 2014.
