Incomplete Land Use Permit Application - Mineral Exploration at Lac de Gras area, NT

The Wek'èezhìi Land and Water Board (WLWB or the Board) received an Application by Peregrine Diamonds Ltd. (Peregrine) to renew Land Use Permit W2011C0005. The aforementioned application has been reviewed in accordance with paragraph 22 (1)(a) of the Mackenzie Valley Land Use Regulations and has been found to be lacking sufficient information. For this application to be considered complete, the following information must be submitted to the WLWB:

1. As per Section 4.4.5 of the [Guide to the Land Use Permitting Process](#), Peregrine must submit a cover letter with the application that clearly states they are applying for preliminary screening exemption and confirm that the project has not been modified or falls under section 157.1 of the MVRMA.
2. As per section 3.1 of the [Guide to the Land Use Permitting Process](#), Peregrine must submit an engagement record and engagement plan. Section 3.1 requires permittees to conduct engagement prior to submitting a land use permit application. The engagement record and engagement plan should be prepared in accordance with section 2.1 of the Boards' [Engagement and Consultation Policy and Engagement Guidelines for Applicants and Holders of Land Use Permits and Water Licences](#).
3. As per subsection 3.2.1, of the [Guide to the Land Use Permitting Process](#), on completing a Land Use Permit Application form, the following must be submitted and/or updated in the Application Form:
 - I. Proof of registration or incorporation (e.g., registration declaration, certificate of incorporation, or certificate of extra-territorial registration) from the GNWT Corporate Registries as an attachment to the application form (Section 1 of the Land Use Permit Application);

- II. Water sources and volumes (maximum volume of water to be used per day) required to support the camp (Section 6.b of the Land Use Permit Application); and
 - III. Circle the type of Land Use Permit Peregrine is applying for (A or B) and include the Application fee (payable to the Receiver General for Canada) with your application (Section 18 of the Land Use Permit Application).
4. As per the [Guidelines for Geographical Information Systems \(GIS\) Submission Standard](#), GIS data should be submitted with the Application. The Board accepts Vector Data (shapefiles with main file, index file and dBase table) and Raster Data; and
 5. Applicants are strongly encouraged to submit a draft security estimate along with their application. Please fill in and submit a draft security estimate, using the following link: [Land Use Permit Security Template](#).

If this supplementary information is not provided within 90 days, then it shall be assumed that you do not wish to continue with the processing of this application, and the application will be returned to you as per Section 25 of the Mackenzie Valley Land Use Regulations.
