
Subject: Final Plan for Camp, Fuel Storage at km 141 on the Dempster Highway

FINAL PLAN DETAILS for G02J007 – Camp and Fuel Storage

- (a) Lands on which the operation was conducted:

The lands utilized for the camp and fuel storage site were located as shown on the accompanying map.

- (b) The location of:

- (i) lines, trails, rights of way and cleared areas that were used by the permittee during the land-use operation, specifying those that were cleared by the permittee and those that existed before the operation began.

There were no lines, trails, rights of way cleared by the permittee.

- (ii) Buildings, structures, campsites, air landing strips, air navigation aids, fuel and supply storage sites, waste disposal sites, excavations and other works and places that were constructed or used by the permittee in the land-use operation.

Buildings utilized – none;

Structures utilized – One trailer was moved in and out;

Campsites utilized – The site applied for was utilized and restored;

Air landing strips – not applicable;

Air navigation aids – not applicable;

Fuel and supply storage – tidy tanks were used to refuel equipment;

Waste disposal sites – all solid waste was trucked to the municipal landfill in Tsiighetchic or Inuvik;

Excavations – a pit was dug for a sewage tank which was pumped out as required. Upon completion, the tank was removed and the site restored.

Other works and places constructed and used by the permittee – none.

- (iii) Bridges, dams, ditches, railroads, transmission lines, pipelines, survey lines, monuments, air landing strips, watercourses, trap lines and cabins and all other features or works that were affected by the land-use operation.

None of the above features or works were affected by this land use operation.

- (c) Calculations of the area of the lands used in the land-use operation.

The calculated area of the lands used in this land use operation is one hectare.
