Please be advised that the Gwich'in Land and Water Board intends to consider, on its own initiative, a one-year renewal of the Hamlet of Fort McPherson Municipal Water Licence G03L3-001, pursuant to subparagraph 36(1)(a)(ii) of the *Waters Act*. The proposed renewals would carry over the terms and conditions of these existing Licences, with no changes except to the expiry date, which would be set to September 1, 2021.

This renewals are being considered due to extenuating circumstances resulting from the COVID-19 pandemic, as the applicant has been unable to fulfill the requirements of a new Water Licence Application.
