**RE: Industry, Tourism and Investment  
Land Use Permit Application - G16X-006  
Quarrying at km 230 and 235  
Campsite Construction at Gwich'in Territorial Park  
Request for Review and Comment**

The Department of Environment and Natural Resources (ENR), Government of the Northwest Territories has reviewed the application at reference based on its mandated responsibilities under the *Environmental Protection Act*, the *Forest Management Act*, the *Forest Protection Act*, *Waters Act* and the *Wildlife Act* and provides the following comments and recommendations for the consideration of the Board.

**Topic: Hazardous Waste**

**Comment(s):**

ITI Parks has been registered as a generator of hazardous waste in the NWT as "NTG582" according to the [Guideline for the General Management of Hazardous Waste in the NWT](#)<sup>i</sup>.

The Guideline for the General Management of Hazardous Waste in the NWT defines hazardous waste and outlines the roles and responsibilities of generators, carriers, and receivers of hazardous waste in the NWT.

ENR, Environment Division registers generators, carriers, receivers, and tracks the disposal of hazardous waste generated in the NWT to authorized receiving facilities on hazardous waste movement documents (manifest).

The application indicates a Waste Management Plan will be provided once the contract has been awarded, however ITI is ultimately responsible for ensuring that the contaminated soils or other hazardous waste generated on-site is disposed of at authorized receiving facilities.

**Recommendation(s):**

- 1) Specify in the Hazardous Waste Management Plan that the ultimate disposal of hazardous waste generated on-site as a result of the park expansion will be documented on hazardous waste movement documents from ITI-Parks (NTG582) to suitably authorized receiving facilities according to the Guideline for the General Management of Hazardous Waste in the NWT.

Comments and recommendations were provided by ENR technical experts in the Environment Division, and the Inuvik Region and were coordinated and collated by the Environmental Impact Assessment Section, Conservation, Assessment and Monitoring Division (CAM).
