**Explanatory Remarks -**

**Fuel Storage and Site:**

During the inspection there were no concerns with the fuel storage, however, the inspectors observed an issue regarding heavy equipment operating at the site without a valid Land Use Permit (LUP) from the Gwich'in Land and Water Board (GLWB). The inspectors spoke with two members at the site who represented the Proponent and have agreed that a LUP would be obtained in the near future for the heavy equipment.

During an inspection in May 2023 the inspector recommended the Proponent amend their LUP to comply with the Mackenzie Valley Land Use Regulations (MVLUR). The Department of Environment and Climate Change would like to again remind the Proponent to submit an amendment (or new application) to the GLWB to include the heavy equipment at the site.
