**Explanatory Remarks -**

**Fuel Storage and Site:**

During the inspection there were a number of concerns observed by the inspector. At the site there were three pieces of heavy equipment that were not mentioned in the application. There was a front-end loader and a D3G Cat parked behind the main building, and a skid steer parked in front of the camp.

There were two trailers approximately 40 feet long intended for occupants at the site, Furthermore, there was approximately 20 loads of gravel material that was recently dumped at the site, behind the main camp.

The heavy equipment, trailers and gravel were not mentioned in the permit application.

The Department of Environment and Climate Change would like to recommend to the Proponent that they amend their Land Use Permit to include the heavy equipment,
