The granular materials to be used are specified in Part E: Construction Item 2. to be clean and free of contaminants, from an authorized source, and should not fall under the definition provided for Waste.</p> <p>The Waste Management Plan appears to be consistent with the scope of the draft licence, and includes Granular Material in the table listing Waste Streams. This should be removed from the Waste Management Plan as the granular materials have a construction purpose, and do not require disposal or management as waste.</p>	<p>ECCC recommends revising the scope of the licence to reference "Deposit of up to 500 m3/year of granular materials..." in Section 1. a)</p> <p>ECCC recommends removing the reference to granular materials in the Waste Management Plan in accordance with their purpose for construction use, rather than disposal.</p>
