The aforementioned application has been reviewed in accordance with Section 22. (1)(a) of the Mackenzie Valley Land Use Regulations, and has been found to be lacking sufficient information to conduct a preliminary screening. In order for this application to be considered complete and forwarded for review, the following information must be submitted to our office:

1. NTS mapsheets (1:50000 if available or 1:250000), indicating locations of each aspect of the operation such as areas to be surveyed and camp location.
2. A to-scale map showing layout of camp, including any water bodies, archaeological/historical sites or other features within 100 metres of the campsite.
3. An estimate of the number of holes to be drilled. This can be reported as a range.
4. A calculation showing the number of hectares of land that will be used, including the camp area, and a payment for the associated land use fees. Land use fees are fifty dollars (\$50.00) per hectare used. The application fee of \$150.00 has been received by this office and does not need to be included.
5. Confirmation that the First Nations and Communities listed on the attached sheet have been consulted in regards to your proposed operations. Also include details about how the consultation was conducted such as if follow-up phone calls or meetings took place.

Upon receipt of this information, the application will be processed and the review period will begin. If you require further guidance, please refer to the document "GUIDE FOR COMPLETING LAND USE PERMIT APPLICATIONS TO THE MACKENZIE VALLEY LAND AND WATER BOARD" which can be found on our Website www.mvlwb.com.

If this supplementary information is not provided within 90 days, then it shall be assumed that you do not wish to continue with the processing of this application, and the application will be returned to you as per Section 25 of the Mackenzie Valley Land Use Regulations. Since the MVLWB cannot issued refunds directly, at that time the request to refund land use fees will be made to the Department of Indian Affairs and Northern Development.
