We are occupiers of the Great Slave Sailing Club(GSSC) property as we are members of the club and it's location for 35 years.

We launch and store and maintain our 30 foot sailboat at the club property. We participate in cruising, racing and other activities such open houses and sailing school lessons. Our boat is stored on land on an immovable cradle during the winter/off season.

We make use of the property from May until September to upkeep and maintain our boat and sail from the wharf to enjoy the waters of Back Bay, Yellowknife Bay and on further trips to the main body of the Great Slave Lake . The winter season from September to May our vessel relies on the property and club surveillance to safely store our boat over the winter.

Our boat is a Fortune 30 Cutter, displacing 16,000 pounds, length 34 feet, beam 11.5 feet, mast height is 40 feet.

Part 4-potential loss

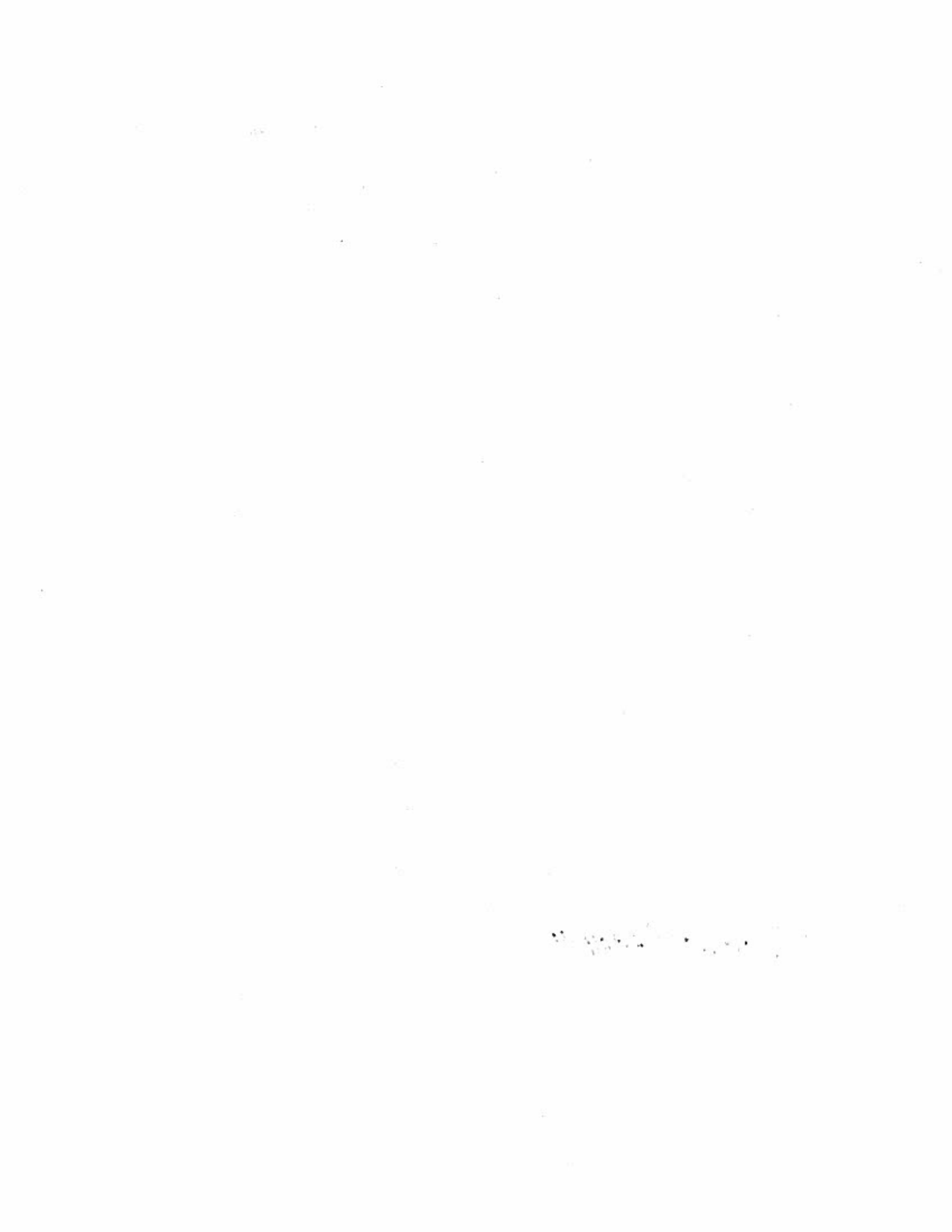
The value of the many boats in our club has been reduced to less than zero due to the uncertainty of whether there will ever be a suitable facility at which we could launch, retrieve and store, maintain our vessel. No one will purchase our boat if there exist NO suitable place to use it and enjoy it. It is likely that boats such as ours will become un-sailable and un-saleable.

The cost of designing-fabricating a suitable trailer to move our vessel even a short distance is prohibitive and would entail highway permits, escort vehicles. It is our intention to file for compensation to address these issues and concerns.
