To follow up further on our conversation this morning, please be aware that the initial invitation for community site visits introduced on April 30th, 2010 was met either with no response or a negative response (e.g. Appendix 6.1, June 16th, e-mail conversation between Todd Slack and Don Aubrey and 7.5-5, e-mail conversation between Todd Slack and Andrew Duthie).

Those groups interested in the proposed Project attended the community site visits during the last week of August/first week of September. These visits were in support of the LUP application and provided the members the opportunity to see the site and raise questions about the proposed Project.
