Greetings to our Inspectors and Regulators,

This is to advise that Peregrine will be conducting a 14- to 18-day programme for the Lac de Gras Project (*MV2011C0005*) and the DO-27 Project (*MV2004C0044*), commencing on **11 August 2011**. Activities will consist of the following: (1) surveying of 17 Lac de Gras mineral claims (one claim in the West block, remainder in the East block) by SubArctic Surveys of Yellowknife [*cf. attached map*], in order to take the claims to lease so that exploration on these areas may continue; (2) ground geophysics (magnetic and electromagnetic surveys) at selected targets across the two projects; and (3) collection by Rio Tinto Exploration Inc., (Rio Tinto) of approximately 82 till samples across 9 claims in the Lac de Gras Project – West Block; Rio Tinto has Peregrine's permission for this separate activity.

By permission of the Winter Road Joint Venture, Peregrine's short field programme will be conducted out of the existing Road Camp located at 64° 25' 05.30" N. Lat. - 110° 06' 42.90" W. Long. (NAD-83). Camp maintenance, cooking and medic support will be provided by the camp. Peregrine's crew will consist of a geologist (project manager, Duncan McBean), a 4-person ground geophysics crew, a 3-person Canada Land Surveyors crew, and a helicopter pilot and engineer. The Road Camp landing strip is accessible to wheeled aircraft for move/demove and supply flights from Yellowknife. Up-to-date copies of the Lac de Gras/DO-27 Spill Plan and Closure & Reclamation Plan, as well as all existing land-use permits will be kept with the field crew.

Based upon geophysical survey results, a drill programme will be planned to test anomalies in winter conditions in **spring 2011**.

A copy of this notice also is being supplied to consultee groups under the MVLWB permit (Lac de Gras Project) and the WLWB permit (DO-27 Project).

I trust that you will find all to be in order; however, please let me know if you have any questions. Best regards, and thanks for the opportunity to provide this information. -- ssp
