1. Purpose/Report Summary

The purpose of this Report is to present to the Mackenzie Valley Land and Water Board (MVLWB/the Board) an Application to assign Land Use Permit (Permit) MV2011C0005 from Peregrine Diamonds Ltd. (Peregrine) to Peregrine Exploration Ltd.

2. Background

- April 28, 2011 – Issuance of Permit MV2011C0005;
- July 8, 2015 – Board staff received an assignment application dated June 25, 2015 and sent an incomplete letter requesting additional information;
- July 21, 2015 – Board staff received some of the additional information requested;
- July 27, 2015 – Review of application commenced;
- August 13, 2015 – Reviewer comments and recommendations due;
- August 20, 2015 – Deadline for Peregrine’s responses to reviewer comments;
- September 25, 2015 – Board staff received outstanding application fees, dated September 8, 2015;
- October 8, 2015 – Assignment application presented to the Board;
- April 27, 2016 – Expiration of Permit MV2011C0005.

3. Discussion

Peregrine Diamonds Ltd. is a separate legal entity from Peregrine Exploration Ltd. and included certificates of registration for both with this Application (attached). They also included a list of mineral leases being transferred, an assignment Application fee and an engagement record.

Peregrine also holds Permit W2011C0005 with the Wek'ezhii Land and Water Board (WLWB); they applied to assign both of these permits at the same time. The Application to assign W2011C0005 will be considered by the WLWB at their next available board meeting.

4. Comments

Board staff have reviewed the inspection reports and correspondence for this file. In 2012, inspectors noted a few minor concerns regarding fuel storage and cleanup of hydrocarbon-impacted materials. Peregrine has responded and the most recent inspection, conducted in 2014, noted no concerns.

On September 30, 2015, Board staff confirmed with the Government of the Northwest Territories, Department of Justice - Corporate Registries that Peregrine Exploration Ltd. is a registered business in good standing in the Northwest Territories.

5. Reviewer Comments

A draft assigned Permit cover page and Permit conditions were distributed with the review of the assignment Application (attached). Administrative updates were made to some conditions to reflect updates following devolution.

By August 13, 2015, only the Government of the Northwest Territories – Department of Environment and Natural Resources had responded, and indicated they had “no comment” (attached).

6. Security

Peregrine Diamonds Ltd. was required by Permit MV2011C0005 to post \$9,000 for reclamation security. Indian Affairs and Northern Development accepted the required security payment on July 11, 2011 (attached).

7. Conclusion

Board staff concludes that this Permit may be assigned. The conditions contained within this draft should mitigate any potential environmental impacts this development may have on the land and water.


8. Recommendation
