**Re: NOTIFICATION of Intent to apply for Mackenzie Valley Land and Water Board
Storage Authorization
for Strategic Oil and Gas Ltd. Cameron Hills Field
Cameron Hills Area, South Slave Region, NT**

Throughout this letter, "Strategic" means "Alvarez and Marsal Canada Inc. in its capacity as the NWT Receiver on behalf of Strategic and not in its personal capacity."

Strategic Oil & Gas Ltd. (Strategic) is entering a sales process for the Cameron Hills Field located southwest of Hay River, south of Tathlina Lake, which extends to the NT/AB border (bounded by the coordinates: 60.0000° N, 117.2100°W and 60.3500°N, 117.6700°W).

The Cameron Hills Field encompasses wellsites (abandoned and suspended), winter access roads, summer all-terrain vehicle (ATV) trails, gas and oil gathering and measurement systems, an electrical distribution system, a central battery (H-03), sump sites, a permanent camp, borrow pits, and bridges (one for vehicle use and two for ATV use). See attached as-built map of the Cameron Hills Field.

Currently the Cameron Hills Field is not in operation. Production was suspended in February 2015 as the economics were not favourable for production. All oil and gas pipelines within the Cameron Hills Field, including the Cameron Hills Transborder Pipeline, have been properly and safely discontinued.

Land Use Permit (LUP) and Storage Authorization Application

The Mackenzie Valley Land and Water Board (MVLWB) LUP MV2013A0010 for the Cameron Hills Field expired September 18, 2020. Strategic applied for, and received, a one (1) year Storage Authorization pursuant to section 16(2) of the Mackenzie Valley Land Use Regulation which expires September 18, 2021. The authorization includes all buildings, equipment, machinery, and materials associated with the Cameron Hills Field since they will be required for future land-use operation in this area.

Since Strategic is entering a sales process for the Cameron Hills Field which will extend past the expiry date of the Storage Authorization, a subsequent one (1) year Storage Authorization is being applied for. If the Cameron Hills Field is acquired by another company, the new owner will apply for appropriate authorizations for their planned activities.
