**Re: Enbridge Pipelines NW Inc. (“Enbridge”)
Type A Land Use Permit MV2013P0011
Request for Extension**

On July 18, 2013, the Mackenzie Valley Land and Water Board (“MVLWB”, or “Board”) approved land use permit MV2013P0011 (“LUP”) for a period of 5 years expiring on July 17, 2018. Enbridge respectfully requests a 2-year extension to the term of land use permit MV2013P0011 as per Section 26(6) of the *Mackenzie Valley Land Use Regulations*.

Land use permit MV2013P0011 is applicable to specified off-right-of-way areas utilized by Enbridge to support operation and maintenance of the Line 21 pipeline from Norman Wells to the Alberta/Northwest Territories border. Typical annual activities associated with the LUP include opening a limited number of accesses to the pipeline right-of-way and maintaining (i.e. brushing) fireguards and work areas as described in the Annual Reports on file with the Board.

Enbridge is focused on completing the work required to re-start the Line 21 pipeline. Enbridge has informed aboriginal stakeholders in the Dehcho and Sahtu regions of its intention to request a 2-year extension for land use permit MV2013P0011 and begin stakeholder engagement regarding the renewal of the LUP after the pipeline is re-started. Pending successful completion of the Line 21 Segment Replacement Project, Enbridge anticipates re-starting the pipeline in Q4 2018.
