Hi Miki

The only updates to the Appendix IV Table 'Enbridge-Norman Wells Pipeline TEK Study Status' is that there is now a signed agreement with LKFN and the TEK Report from LKFN is in progress. Enbridge has also received a proposal from PKFN for TEK work; this proposal has yet to be agreed.

With regards to copies of the TEK studies that have been completed (Tulita; Sambia K'e), Enbridge has requested these reports from our contractor (MWH), but has yet to receive them. In an unfortunate twist of fate, the project lead at MWH is on holiday until tomorrow and his second is likewise unavailable – so I have been unable to get an update as to when we can expect those reports. We will submit them as soon as they are finalized, and I should be able to give you a better idea of timeline later this week (sorry – I know this will miss the Board package deadline).
